

Frequently Asked Summer Camp Questions

Q: Is the first week pro-rated since there are only 4 days (closed Memorial Day)?

A: Yes, it is \$200 instead of \$250

Q: Dose my student need to pack a lunch every day?

A: Yes, except Wednesday, we will provide pizza. It is cheese pizza. If they don't like pizza, they can pack their lunch that day, as well. They also need to pack snacks for each day.

Q: Is there any sibling discounts?

A: Yes! And it is different this year! One child pays full price, second child gets 10% off, third child gets 20% off, fourth child gets 30% off, and so on. This is only if they are coming the same day/week.

Q: What are the age groupings?

A: This is a little different this year – 5-7 years, 8-10 years, and 11-13 years.

Q: Will there be field trips?

A: Not off-site field trips but on-site ones! We will be bringing the fun to us!

Q: When will the on-site Field Trips be?

A: Each week in our Weekly Newsletters will state when our onsite field trips will be. It won't be finalized until around May 15th.

Q: Do I have to keep a card on file?

A: Yes, but you don't have to be on auto charge. You can come in and pay each week with cash or check or pay ahead. If we don't receive payment by Monday evening, when you pick your child up, your card on file will be charged.

Q: Can I fill out the Registration Form when I get there?

A: No! The Registration Form needs filled out in advance and approved (signed by Brittany).

Q: Do I have to have the JFS Forms to attend?

A: Yes, everyone must have JFS Form 01234

Example: If your child needs an inhaler and an EpiPen, they will need 2 forms of 1217 and 2 forms of 1236 (one for each medication onsite)

We ONLY administer emergency meds. If a child needs a daily pill mom or dad would need to bring it to them if its during camp hours.
